DETAILED ITINERARY

DAY 1 - FEBRUARY 19, 2025 DEPART US

DAY 2 - FEBRUARY 20

ARRIVE KILIMANJARO AIRPORT - TANZANIA / ARUSHA

Arrive Kilimanjaro Airport. On arrival you will clear customs and immigration, claim your luggage, and will be met outside of baggage claim by your Safari Legacy guides and transferred to the **Lake Duluti Lodge** for overnight.

DAY 3 - FEBRUARY 21 ARUSHA

Full day at leisure. Overnight Lake Duluti Lodge. *Meals: B, D*

DAY 4 - FEBRUARY 22

GOOD HOPE ORPHANAGE / ARUSHA NATIONAL PARK / TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

After an early breakfast and safari briefing, visit the Good Hope Orphanage. Afterwards travel to the montane forests of Arusha National Park, in search of the black and white colobus monkey. After our lunch, depart for Tarangire National Park, with a game drive on the way to our tented camp. Overnight **Tarangire Kuro Treetops Lodge**. *Meals: B, L, D*

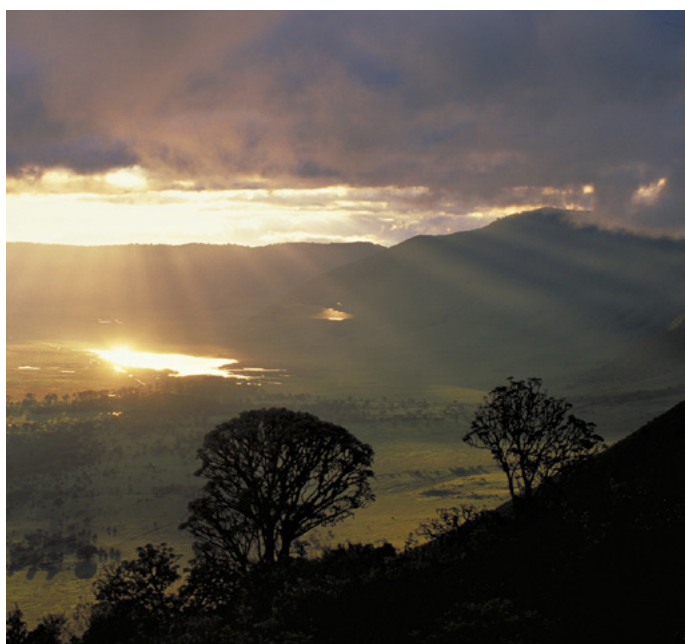
DAYS 5 & 6 - FEBRUARY 23 & 24

TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

Enjoy two full days exploring Tarangire National Park, renowned for its large herds of elephants and a diverse wildlife population of more than 2,500 individuals and more than 260 bird species that inhabit an iconic landscape punctuated by magnificent baobab trees. Overnight **Tarangire Kuro Treetops Lodge**. *Meals: B, L, D*

DAY 7 - FEBRUARY 25 NGORONGORO HIGHLANDS

After a final morning game drive, depart Tarangire National Park towards the Ngorongoro where we stop for lunch, a visit at a small wood carving factory and shopping at the African Galleria. Overnight **Country Lodge**. *Meals: B, L, D*



DAYS 8-10 - FEBRUARY 26-28

SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK – (SERONERA)

Drive to the Serengeti National Park. Enjoy morning and afternoon game drives each day. Overnight **Serengeti Sametu Camp**. *Meals: B, L, D*

DAYS 11 & 12 - MARCH 1 & 2

SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK (NDUTU)

We enjoy the next two days in the Ndtu region of the Serengeti with morning and afternoon game drives each day. Overnight **Sense of Wilderness Ndtu Camp**. *Meals: B, L, D*

DAYS 13 & 14 - MARCH 3 & 4 NGORONGORO CRATER

Drive to the Ngorongoro Crater stopping to visit a Maasai Village and Olduvai Gorge en-route. Olduvai Gorge, one of the most important prehistoric archaeological sites on Earth: It was here in the 1950s that Louis and Mary Leakey first uncovered the fossilized teeth and skull of one of our earliest ancestors. Enjoy an afternoon game drive in the Crater. Then Drive to the Ngorongoro Crater stopping to visit a Maasai Village and Olduvai Gorge en-route. Olduvai Gorge, one of the most important prehistoric archaeological sites on Earth: It was here in the 1950s that Louis and Mary Leakey first uncovered the fossilized teeth and skull of one of our earliest ancestors. Enjoy an afternoon game drive in the Crater. Then enjoy a full day exploring the Ngorongoro Crater, pausing mid-day for a picnic lunch. Overnight **Ngorongoro Serena Lodge**. *Meals: B, L, D*

DAY 15 - MARCH 5

RETURN TO ARUSHA FOR DEPARTURE

After breakfast return to Arusha in time for lunch and shopping at the Cultural Heritage Center. Dayrooms are included at the Lake Duluti Lodge until our transfer to the airport for departing flights. *Meals: B, L*

DAY 16 - MARCH 6 AMSTERDAM / US

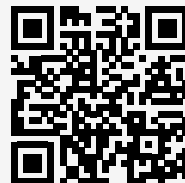
